

# Vaccinations Now Available

## for LA County ECE Providers 65 and Older

Getting vaccinated is an important step you can take to protect yourself and others from COVID-19. In Los Angeles County, people who work in child care and early education are a priority to be vaccinated. At this time, the LA County Department of Public Health and Children's Hospital Los Angeles are beginning a targeted vaccination distribution for early care and education providers who are 65 years and older.

### Who Can Get the Vaccine through this Program?

You can get vaccinated if you are:

- 65 or older
- And**
- Work at an early care and education program in LA County

*You are eligible even if your program is currently providing distance learning or is closed. This includes teaching staff, administrators, custodians, kitchen staff, front office attendants, and other site staff.*

### How Do I Make an Appointment?

All appointments will be offered at:

- Select your language and click "Check my eligibility."
- Answer the questions and enter CHLAECE under Accessibility Code.
- Enter your zip code and click "See availability" under Children's Hospital Los Angeles to see available appointments.

**The number of appointments available through this program are limited.** If you do not get an appointment here and you are 65 or older, you are still eligible to sign up for any available appointment at [vaccinatelacounty.com](https://vaccinatelacounty.com).



## What Documentation is Needed?

You must bring documentation showing that you are 65 or older and proof of that you are employed in early care and education. The documentation differs slightly by provider type. Please see below for the documents you must bring to your vaccination appointment.

## What Should I Expect at My Appointment?

- You will check in and show your 1) appointment confirmation, 2) ID showing you are age 65 or older, and 3) documentation that you work in early care and education (see table above.)
- You will receive a paper or electronic version of a fact sheet that tells you more about the specific COVID-19 vaccine you are being offered.
- Once you have been vaccinated, you will be monitored for 15-30 minutes to make sure you do not have any adverse reactions.
- You will receive a vaccination card or printout that tells you what COVID-19 vaccine you received, the date you received it, and where you received it.
- You will make an appointment for your second dose or get directions to schedule an appointment for your second dose. Currently, all vaccines being offered in LA County require two doses.
